

Local artist wins festival contest

The entry of Indianapolis artist James Cunningham has been awarded top prize in the contest to select a commemorative poster for next year's National Sports Festival, it was announced Tuesday.

Cunningham's entry, a multi-colored abstraction, was selected by Hoosier-born artist Robert Indiana, who judged nearly 50 entries Saturday at the Indianapolis Art League, which coordinated the competition. The contest was sponsored by the arts and cultural division of the National Sports Festival Committee.

Cunningham, a graduate of Herron School of Art, IU/PUI, will receive \$1,000 provided by the Penrod Society. His design will be reproduced by color

offset printing to advertise the festival which will draw more than 2,600 amateur athletes here to compete in 33 sports, July 23-31, 1982.

Junior merit award winners, who will receive \$250 cash prizes, are Roland Hobart of Shelbyville and Jerry Carey of Greensburg.

Finalists in the competition were Deborah Hirtze, Garry Nichols, Orlando Pelaez and James Faust of Indianapolis; Larry Zimbleman of Greenwood; and Jim Gasting of Lafayette.
